Title of Study: Economic Recession and the American Dream

Investigator: Dr. Sunghhee Nam, California State University Channel Islands

Purpose: This study investigates how the current economic recession is affecting residents in Ventura County, how they are coping with their hardship, and how this experience is changing their views on American society and government.

Participation: If you volunteer for this study, we ask you to participate in an interview. The interview will be tape-recorded if you give your consent below. The interview should take approximately one hour and will include some questions about your personal experience with the current economic recession. While participating in this study presents no foreseeable risk to you, it may present a time inconvenience for you. Overall, the risk involved is no more than one would experience in normal daily activities. A potential benefit to you is the opportunity to contribute to the greater understanding of the current economic recession.

Confidentiality: The information you give will be studied in a manner that protects your identity. A pseudonym will be assigned to you so that your real name does not appear on any of the study materials. All the information you provide will be stored on a secured internal sharedrive accessible only to the two researchers conducting this study. When data is no longer needed it will be destroyed upon completion of this study.


